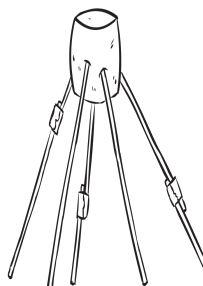


CREATIVITY CHOICE BOARD

Choose 2 options to work on this week. Feel free to modify the options if you do not have the materials listed at home. Take this opportunity to apply the art skills that you have learned this semester to your work this week, try something new & have fun being creative!



<p>NOTECARD CHALLENGE</p> <p>Use note cards to create a 3-D tower. Bend and fold the note cards to get them to stand without using tape or glue. Challenge a family member to see who can create the tallest tower :)</p>	<p>NATURE ART</p> <p>Collect natural objects like leaves, twigs, and rocks while on a walk outside. Arrange the objects to create an interesting design or picture and take a picture of what you create :)</p>	<p>MINDFULNESS ART</p> <p>Create a drawing that relates to how you are feeling today or to an emotion that you have had in the past. Use colors that relate to your mood to color your drawing and listen to music while you draw :)</p>
<p>STYROFOAM CUP ART</p> <p>Look at examples of zentangle patterns online and use a pen or marker to draw patterns on a styrofoam cup inspired by the zentangle designs that you find online :)</p>	<p>MARSHMALLOW SCULPTURE</p> <p>Use marshmallows and toothpicks to build a tower or sculpture. Take it a step further and build a miniature city with buildings :)</p>	<p>STILL LIFE DRAWING</p> <p>Gather 2-3 objects from around your house and arrange them in an interesting way. Use paper to draw a sketch of the arrangement you created.</p>
<p>MUSICAL DRAWING</p> <p>Use pencils, crayons, colored pencils, markers, pens, or other available materials to create different line drawings inspired by different types of music. Play to 3-4 different songs and create different illustrations inspired by the sounds, rhythms, and vibrations of the music.</p>	<p>GROUND COFFEE PAINTING</p> <p>Take a ½ cup of coffee and treat it like watercolor paint. Mix 1-2 tablespoon of coffee grounds with ½ cup of water to create your medium. Practice painting with your new medium on a paper plate. Try using an old toothbrush instead of a paintbrush :)</p>	<p>RECYCLED SCULPTURE</p> <p>Use leftover boxes, containers, and cans to create a sculpture. Go a step further and use these materials to create a prototype for a new invention inspired by the materials that you choose to use to create your art :)</p>
