6th Grade Art

Projects we work on include: Cubism self-portraits, 3-D dream bedroom designs in perspective, infographic poster illustrations, and celebration clay masks.

7th Grade Art

7th grade Art is a semester course for students during the elective block in the junior high schedule. This year, students will have several opportunities to learn about different artists and styles of art from around the world, learn about how art and design influences their everyday lives, and explore how they can use a variety of art materials to illustrate various concepts and techniques. Projects we work on include: art appropriation painting, color scheme shield designs, amusement park perspective, balancing toys, and Pop Art ceramics.

8th Grade Art
